Momentum Books will continue to preserve much of its regional character, primarily because most of its authors come from the Midwest.

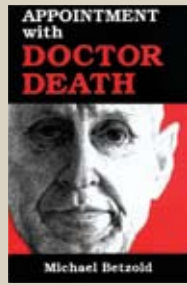
